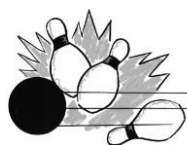
*9 pins knocked down on the 1st ball = a STRIKE!!*

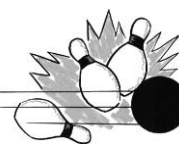

### MINIMUM GUARANTEED PRIZES FOR THIS EVENT:

35 Entries or Less:	1st: 50% of prize fund	2nd: 30% of prize fund	3rd: 20% of prize fund
36 to 45 Entries:	1st: \$250.00	2nd: \$125.00	3rd: \$65.00
46 to 55 Entries:	1st: \$300.00	2nd: \$150.00	3rd: \$75.00
56 to 65 Entries:	1st: \$350.00	2nd: \$175.00	3rd: \$90.00

- If there are more than 65 entries, the guaranteed prizes will increase accordingly.
- Exactly 1 in 10 will be paid and exactly 1 in 10 will qualify for the Finals.
- Bowlers may re-enter multiple times, and cash as many times as they participate, but can cash only once in the guaranteed prize list.

### THERE WILL BE THREE (3) OPTIONAL POOLS RUN DURING THIS EVENT:

#### • **SCRATCH POOL – \$5.00 Per Entry**

Three (3) games total pinfall without handicap to determine winners. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1<sup>st</sup>: 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup>: 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup>: 15%, 4<sup>th</sup>: 10%.

#### • **HIGH SINGLE POOL – \$2.00 Per Entry**

Scratch and handicapped high single games will be paid. A bowler can win only one (1) prize per entry. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out. The number of winners and the amount of each prize is based on the number of entries.

#### • **DOUBLES POOL – \$6.00 Per Team**

Both members of a team must bowl on the same shift. Each bowler takes his or her three games of the tournament. Handicap will be 80% based on a 360 average limit. A bowler can enter only once each time they bowl in the tournament. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1<sup>st</sup>: 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup>: 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup>: 20%.

## OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Bowlers must be current members of the National Duckpin Bowling Congress.
- B. Tournament entrance average will be:
  - 1. 2023-2024 composite average of all sanctioned games bowled in RI adult leagues and tournaments (21 games or more).
  - 2. Out of state bowlers who are not covered by Rule B.1. will use a 2023-2024 composite average comprised of all sanctioned games bowled in their home area plus all sanctioned games bowled in RI (total pinfall / number of games = composite average) (21 games or more).
  - 3. If above does not apply, then 2022-2023 composite average of all sanctioned games bowled in RI adult leagues and tournaments will be used (21 games or more).
  - 4. Out of state bowlers who are not covered by rules above will use a 2022-2023 composite average comprised of all sanctioned games bowled in their home area plus all sanctioned games bowled in RI (total pinfall / number of games = composite average) (21 games or more).
  - 5. If above does not apply, then 2024 highest sanctioned adult summer league average will be used (21 games or more). Proof of average is mandatory.
- C. If above does not apply, the entrant will bowl scratch (160 average).

\*Tournament entrance averages have been adjusted for 9-Pin No-Tap based on the probability of higher average bowlers knocking down 9-pins on the 1st ball (receiving a strike) than a lower average bowler. By increasing the average slightly, it gives the lower average bowler a better opportunity to cash. If a bowler's average is 90 or under, the no-tap average is the same as the tournament entrance average.
