- I. A) Bowlers must be current members of the National Duckpin Bowling Congress.
  - B) Tournament entrance average will be:
    - 1. 2022-2023 Composite Average of all sanctioned games in RI adult leagues and tournaments (21 games or more).
    - 2. If above does not apply, then 2021-2022 Composite Average of all sanctioned games bowled in RI adult leagues and tournaments will be used (21 games or more).
    - 3. If above does not apply, then 2023-2024 highest sanctioned adult winter league average will be used (21 games or more). Proof of average is mandatory.
    - 4. If above does not apply, then 2023 highest sanctioned adult summer league average will be used (21 games or more). Proof of average is mandatory.
  - C) Out of state bowlers who are not covered by Rule B will use a composite average comprised all sanctioned games bowled in their home area plus all sanctioned leagues bowled in RI (total pinfall / number of games = composite average).
  - D) If above does not apply, the entrant will bowl scratch (160 average), until 21 game 9-Pin No-Tap average is established.

\*Book averages have been adjusted for 9-Pin No-Tap based on the probability of higher average bowlers knocking down 9-pins on the 1st ball (receiving a strike) than a lower average bowler. By increasing the average slightly, it gives the lower average bowler a better opportunity to cash.

If a bowler's average is 90 or under, the no-tap average is the same as the book average.
